

Who We Are

The Czech Development Agency (CZDA) is a state organization under the authority of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) of the Czech Republic and an implementing body of the Czech Development Cooperation.

The Agency's main objective is to reduce poverty, improve a quality of life and promote sustainable development.

In 2016, CZDA financially supported 154 projects in 12 countries on 3 continents.

The Agency was founded on January 1st, 2008. Since July 1, 2010, the Agency was formally re-established by the Act on Development Cooperation and Humanitarian Assistance.

In 2017, CZDA manages a budget of 513,200,000 CZK (approx. 19,220,000 EUR). As a modern donor, the CZDA cooperates with various groups of actors - the state sector and local authorities, non-profit sector, universities and private sector.

Types of projects


- Public tenders

Real expenditures by countries 2016¹


